In recent years, the expertly set trails for skiing, walking, and even dog-friendly adventures have drawn visitors from across the city—and beyond.

But even cherished community gems need care and a vision to keep them vibrant.



A Vision Born from a Challenge

In 2023, a fire damaged the park's equipment facility—a critical setback for maintaining the trails. But what began as a challenge sparked something extraordinary. Volunteers, the City of Regina, local businesses, and the Regina Ski Club came together with a bigger dream: not just to repair, but to reimagine what Kinsmen Park South could be. Phase one of this ambitious multi-year project focuses on three key investments:



New Low Trees and Shrubs

- Strategically planted greenery will act as windbreaks, providing shelter on our blustery prairie days and ensuring that fresh snow does not blow away, extending the ski season.
- The enhanced landscape will boost biodiversity and create a more inviting, beautiful park.



A New Nordic Multipurpose Building (to replace the damaged building)

- A larger, more efficient facility to store equipment for trail setting, maintenance and equipment repairs.
- Serve as a potential waxing center and rest area for skiers.
- Operational in the fall for the 2025/26 ski season.



Enhanced Spaces for Learning and Training

- Dedicated and expanded multi-track area for learn-to-ski programs, training sessions and ski races bringing even more energy and excitement to the park.
- The development of future provincial and national athletes, coaches, officials and volunteers.
- Wayfinding and information signage.





Looking Ahead: 2026 and Beyond

Phase one is just the beginning!

The momentum we create in Phase one will carry forward into even bigger enhancements in future phases, thanks to the unique leadership by the City of Regina, Regina Ski Club, the Lakeview Community Association, dedicated volunteers, and many other stakeholders.
